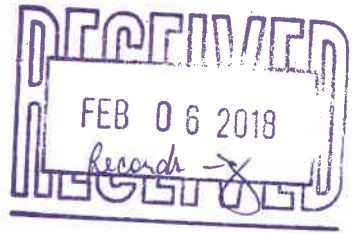


**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE
2017 FARMERS SATISFACTION SURVEY**



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement entered into by and between:

The **NATIONAL IRRIGATION ADMINISTRATION**, a government-owned and controlled corporation created under existing Philippine Laws with principal address at National Government Center, Epifanio de Los Santos Avenue, Quezon City, Philippines, represented in this agreement by **BENITO T. ESPIQUE JR.**, Acting Regional Manager of National Irrigation Administration- CAR, with postal address at Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet, herein referred to as **NIA**;

The **MOUNTAIN PROVINCE STATE OF POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE**, a tertiary educational institution established under existing Philippine laws, with main campus located at Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province represented in this Agreement by **REXTON F. CHAKAS**, College President, hereinafter referred to as the **SUC**;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, NIA provides its farmer- clientele with various services such as cropping calendar implementation, water delivery and distribution, construction/ rehabilitation of irrigation facilities and structures, advisory/ support services and training;

WHEREAS, NIA wishes to assess the level of satisfaction of the above- mentioned services from the point of view of the farmers so that the Agency can identify what specific aspect of service(s), need(s) improvement and sustain those that have positive effects;

WHEREAS, one way for NIA to gauge the level of satisfaction is through the conduct of a Farmers' Satisfaction Survey (FSS) to be done by an independent third party to eliminate any forms of biases;

WHEREAS, the SUC has the expertise, experience and capability to undertake the Farmers' Satisfaction Survey (FSS) and NIA wishes to engage the SUCs services for this purpose;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing premises, the parties and the mutual covenant herein contained, the parties have agreed as follows:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The **NIA** shall:

1. Orient the **SUC** on the purposes, objectives, expected outputs and other requirements of the FSS;
2. Provide the **SUC** the list of farmers to be interviewed with their respective addresses and contact numbers;
3. Reproduce the questionnaire in enough copies and supply these to the **SUC**;
4. Pay the **SUC** the amount of Sixty One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 61, 950.00) for the conduct of the FSS after the outputs/ deliverables are submitted by the SUC and such outputs are verified to conform to the Agreement. All payments under this Agreement shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations; and
5. Cause the notarization of this Memorandum of Agreement prior to the date of the start of the FSS and furnish one (1) original copy to **SUC**.

The **SUC** shall:

1. Prepare and submit to **NIA** a Work Plan after the signing of this Agreement based on the purposes and objectives of the FSS detailing thereat the set of activities related to the conduct of FSS including the timetable to accomplish them;
2. Conduct the FSS using the questionnaires provided by **NIA** (attached as Annexes 1 & 2) in the irrigation systems and Irrigators Associations (IAs) covered and according to the number of respondents included in the list provided by **NIA**;
3. Consolidate and tabulate the results according to the format then attached as Annex 4 and submit the hard and electronic copies of these results to **NIA**;
4. Surrender to **NIA** all the filled-up questionnaires that were used in the conduct of FSS; and
5. Use the gathered data for a full blown research.
