



## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA)



### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**, made and entered into by and between the **MOUNTAIN PROVINCE STATE POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE**, a public tertiary educational institution, existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with principal office address at Bontoc, Mountain Province, represented by its President, **REXTON F. CHAKAS, Ph.D.**, hereinafter referred to as **MPSPC**;

and

The Philippine National Police - **Mountain Province Police Provincial Office** a government organization existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at Bontoc, Mountain Province represented by its Police Provincial Director, **PCOL RUBEN B. ANDISO**, hereinafter referred to as **MPPPO**;

### WITNESSETH:

**WHEREAS**, the **MPSPC** is a duly recognized and accredited higher institution by the Commission of Higher Education (CHED) offering various courses on the field of Education, Accountancy and Business education, Health Care, Engineering, Agriculture and Forestry, Criminal Justice, Social Science and Governance, and Advance Education;

**WHEREAS**, in pursuit to its mission one of which is to assist the country in the shared struggles for national development is extending services and programs through research and extension services through its *Gameng di Sumyaan Program* which encompasses the extension and community services offered by the various schools/departments of the College to wit:

**WHEREAS**, the **Research Development and Extension Sector** may also introduce viable projects related to the above programs to be piloted in the community;

**WHEREAS**, to succeed in the delivery of the services and programs to the community, MPSPC through it RDE Sector needs partners or collaborators;

**WHEREAS**, the **Mountain Province Police Provincial Office** is willing to be partners and collaborator on this endeavor, conscious of the fact that education play a vital role in community development;

**WHEREAS**, **MPPPO** considers the partnership with MPSPC as part of its mission to prevent and control crimes, maintain peace and order, and ensure public safety in partnership with the community;

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**WHEREAS, MPPPO** is cognizant of the best interest of the youth, hence undertakes to collaborate with MPSPC for the successful implementation of the RDE through its Gameng di Sumyaan Program.

**NOW THEREFORE,** for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby enter into this memorandum and mutually agree to:

**BOTH PARTIES shall:**

1. Disseminate information about the research and extension services anchored on the HERITAGE thrust of the incumbent administration;
2. Seek to identify a common working ground whereby sharing of resources and other collaborative means in order to advance their respective mandates;
3. Coordinate with each other as to the date and venue of the trainings, seminars and workshops;
4. Share data and information relevant to RDE governed by each parties' Freedom of Information Manual
5. Issue training certificates to participants and certificates of appreciation to trainers/resource persons duly signed by heads of both parties; and
6. Share responsibility on the funding (if available) of the identified needed activities and trainings and recommend measures for the improvement of the joint venture.

**THE MPSPC shall:**

1. Conduct baseline surveys and needs analysis, and other researches as basis for the crafting of activities and interventions to the clientele;
2. Prepare activity designs and conduct trainings, seminars or workshops based on identified problems and needs of the clientele;
3. Grant service credits to faculty and staff who will serve as resource persons during extension activities held on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, with the assumption that all necessary requirements for the conduct of the said activities are duly approved;
4. Be responsible for the transportation and per diems of resource speakers and drivers from the College who are involved in the projects;
5. Provide supplies and materials needed during seminars/trainings and workshops where they are involved in;
6. Conduct impact assessment studies on the training services provided by both parties; and
7. Link with other national agencies and other potential partners who can assist on the pursuit of school and community development.
8. Ensure that all the data and information provided by the MPPPO for the purpose of research shall be treated with utmost confidentiality and abide with the non-disclosure policy.


**THE PNP- Mountain Province Police Provincial Office shall:**

1. Assign a competent personnel to liaise with MPSPC whenever there are activities/ programs to ensure the efficient implementation of the MOA;
2. Lend its expertise through discussions/ workshops/ trainings that MPSPC will organize; and
3. Monitor and evaluate the trainings, seminars and workshops through the Gameng di Sumyaan Program by accomplishing the evaluation tool provided by MPSPC.
4. Facilitate the access of data for research purposes following research protocols, data privacy act and the PNP FOI Manual.
5. Undertake collaborative research align to the PNP Agenda.
6. Conduct activities on peace and order advocacies with MPSPC Students.

**TERM and TERMINATION**

1. Effective Date and Termination : This Agreement shall take effect on the date of the joint signing hereof and shall continue to be in full for and effect for one (1) year and is renewable every year. The parties shall submit their intention for the renewal of this agreement through formal notice.

This agreement, however, may be pre-terminated by mutual agreement of the parties for a good and sufficient cause



2. **Governing Law:** The validity, construction and interpretation of this Agreement and the rights and duties of both parties shall be governed by existing laws of the Republic of the Philippines.
